What NOT to bring to Scripps College

PLEASE NOTE THAT THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED ON CAMPUS

COMMON KITCHENS PROVIDE ALL THE NECESSARY ITEMS FOR

COOKING IN YOUR HALL.

Unauthorized

Halogen bulbs or halogen lamps
Hotplates, skillets, toaster ovens
Instapots, rice cookers
Microwaves (only acceptable if it's a Micro-fridge)
Candles, incense, any items that have an open flame
Lighters

Alcohol (empty or full containers in a room of a student under 21)

Drugs, drug paraphernalia

Vape devices (Scripps is a smoke free campus)

Unauthorized pets

Air conditioners

Hammocks

Knife sets (over 4 inches)

Plug in decorative lights

Non-surge protected power strips, extension cords

Outside furniture and beds

Only students with approved accommodations through ARS can be considered for non-college owned beds

Unauthorized items may be confiscated, or the student may be asked to remove the item from campus
