Students who enter Scripps as First Years must complete all GE requirements by the end of the first semester of senior year.

CORE - Must be taken in sequence

Core 1 – *complete in fall* 

Core 2 – *complete in spring* 

Core 3 – complete in fall

**Breadth of Study** – One course must be taken in each Breadth of Study; no double-counting between breadth requirements.

- MUS 003, MUS 081; any other music theory or music history. No Music lessons, ensembles, or performance

- CLAS course (excludes Greek, Hebrew, and Latin through the intermediate lvl)
- Any RLST course
- Courses from the **SC Letters** course area on the portal
- Any POLI, POST, GOVT course
